Current Situation

Alcohol, Gaming, Fuel & Tobacco is in receipt of an Infraction Report and Statutory Declaration issued by Ron Downey, Compliance Officer with Alcohol, Gaming, Fuel & Tobacco.

The Infraction Report and Statutory Declaration allege violations of the *Nova Scotia Bingo Regulations*. Infractions were issued on November 8, 2018 to Parrsboro Radio Society Bingo, 396 Upper Main Street, Parrsborro, Nova Scotia, Bingo License #104474-17.

It is alleged that the Parrsboro Radio Society Bingo is in violation of sections 6(2) of the *Nova Scotia Bingo Regulations* which states:

Receipts and expenses

6(2) The net operating receipts from the conduct and management of a bingo must constitute a minimum of 15% of gross receipts

Based on the contents of the Infraction Report and Statutory Declaration, the Executive Director of Alcohol, Gaming, Fuel & Tobacco has reasonable grounds to believe that the alleged violations have occurred and has cancelled the bingo license held by the Parrsboro Radio Society as detailed below.

Relevant Legislation

Section 10 (c) and (d) of the Nova Scotia Bingo Regulations and section 112 of the Nova Scotia Gaming Control Act state:

Bingo Regulations

Amendment, suspension, cancellation

- 10 The Executive Director may amend, suspend or cancel a license where
 - (c) a licensee breaches any term or condition of the license or any provision of the Act or these regulations;
 - (d) the Executive Director determines it is in the public interest to amend, suspend or cancel the license;
