Linacy Fire Department has applied for a Club License, for the premises known as Linacy Fire Department. To be located at 6735 Hwy 4, Linacy, Nova Scotia, this application will be open for comment until:

Tuesday June 6, 2023 at 4:30 pm

The approximate square footage of the proposed Club is **2652 square feet**; the approximate maximum number of persons that the licensed premises may hold is **221 persons**. Should the club application be successful, the applicant has indicated that they intend to offer live amplified, live non-amplified and amplified background entertainment.

The maximum hours during which a Club may be authorized to sell or dispense liquor is from 10am -2am Monday to Sundays, this may not be the intention of the applicant.

Comments must be submitted prior to the deadline above and must contain the following information or they will not be considered:

- (a) name, address and phone number of the person providing the comment or objection;
- (b) name of the applicant or licensee, or the location of premises, that is the subject of the comment or objection;
- (c) nature of the comment or objection.
