Requirements resulting from licensing inspection:

1. HSCR 38(2)

The storage area for drugs shall be kept locked at all times and only the pharmacist for the home, the administrator of the home and persons authorized by the administrator shall have access to the drug storage area.

2. LTCPR 12.1.6

The licensee shall ensure hazardous products that may be harmful to residents are secured at all times and are not accessible to residents. They are stored and disposed of in accordance with established safety practices/manufacturers' recommendations.

3. LTCPR 12.1.4.c

The licensee shall ensure the following processes are developed and followed: ensuring compliance with Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) regulations. Current Material Safety Data Sheets for all applicable products used/stored in the home are maintained and are easily accessible to staff members.

4. HSCR 18(2)

In every nursing home and nursing care section of a home for special care where there are less than thirty residents, there shall be at least one registered nurse on duty for no less than eight hours every day, and in the absence of the registered nurse, there shall be a person on duty in the home who is capable of providing emergency care.
