Requirements resulting from licensing inspection:

1. HSCR 31, LTCPR 12.2.2.2.f
The licensee shall ensure aesthetic, functional and surface integrity of the following are maintained: all furnishings, equipment, exposed mechanical and electrical systems and components such as, but not limited to, fixtures, trim, devices, enclosures and fabrics.
2. LTCPR 6.3.6
The licensee shall ensure staff members document timely, clear, objective and complete information on the resident record.
3. LTCPR 8.4.4
The licensee shall ensure there is an active program for the prevention, control and investigation of infectious, communicable diseases. This includes the monitoring of infection rates (surveillance) and the sharing of this information, internally and with the Department of Health and Wellness upon request.
4. LTCPR 6.3.11
Additional Requirements for Residential Care Facilities - The licensee shall ensure each resident's plan of care is based on the needs identified through the collection of resident information, referenced in section 6.1, Additional Requirements for Residential Care Facilities.
5. LTCPR 8.4.8
The licensee shall ensure personal protective equipment is available to protect staff, volunteers and visitors as per routine practices and additional precautions.

- 6.** HSCR 42(1)
The administrator of the home shall be responsible for ensuring that all medications are properly administered to residents in the home.
- 7.** LTCPR 6.2.17
The licensee shall ensure a process is in place to review wound care issues/practices to ensure wound prevention and management is regularly reviewed and revised to reflect leading practices and provincial direction, and identify trends for quality improvement.
- 8.** LTCPR 12.2.2.2.e
The licensee shall ensure aesthetic, functional and surface integrity of the following are maintained: building systems, furnishings and equipment such as, but not limited to, plumbing, heating, ventilation, power, lighting, emergency power, fire alarm, voice and data in accordance with manufacturers' guidelines and/or requirements.
- 9.** LTCPR 8.4.12
The licensee shall ensure staff influenza immunization rates, in homes with greater than 5 employees, are posted in a public place and updated a minimum of twice per year on December 15th and on March 1st.
