Requirements resulting from licensing inspection:

1. LTCPR 7.1.5

The licensee shall ensure the policies listed in Appendix A and accompanying procedures, and any other policies and procedures deemed necessary by the licensee, are developed, documented and implemented.

2. LTCPR 6.3.5

The licensee shall ensure interventions, outcomes and resident progress are regularly evaluated and the plan of care is modified as needed and documented on the resident record.

3. LTCPR 8.2.1.b

The licensee shall ensure policies and procedures that minimize risk to residents, staff, volunteers, visitors and the home are developed and followed. These include but are not limited to: a critical incident reporting policy and procedures that direct staff in the event of a critical incident.

4. LTCPR 6.3.4.a

The licensee shall ensure each resident has a plan of care which includes the plan's rationale, measurable and achievable goals, benefits, expected outcomes, detailed actions that the interdisciplinary team shall undertake to meet the resident'sidentified needs and time frames for evaluation.

5. LTCPR 6.5.2.c

The licensee shall ensure the following processes are developed and followed: labeling of food in refrigerators and discarding of expired food.

6. HSCR 20B, LTCPR 7.4.3

The licensee shall ensure management and staff meetings are held a minimum of quarterly.

7. LTCPR 8.5.12

The licensee shall ensure MARs are reviewed and double-checked for accuracy by two authorized staff members before being utilized.

8. LTCPR 11.1.2

The licensee shall ensure pre-employment Vulnerable Sector Checks are completed for staff members, students and volunteers at the time of hire and are maintained on file.
