Requirements resulting from licensing inspection:

1. HSCR 42(2), RCW Minimum Training Standard

No person shall administer any drug to a resident of a home for special care unless her has been designated by the administrator as a person who is competent to do so. All RCW's are required to meet all Minimum Training Standards. These include: an annual refresher for Fire and Life Safety, Medication Awareness and Personal Care by acceptable trainers, First Aid and CPR refreshers according to the frequency established by certifying agencies and a Crisis Prevention (or equivalent relevant course) refresher as determined by the facility's administrator.

2. HSCR 20A(1), LTCPR 9.1.2

The licensee shall ensure a labour disruption contingency plan, which may be included in the business continuity plan, is developed in consultation with service partners as appropriate.

3. LTCPR 8.5.8

The licensee shall ensure signatures of staff who administer medications are verified annually, or as needed, when a paper based system is utilized.

4. LTCPR 7.1.12

The licensee shall ensure required inspections of the home and equipment are completed and documentation is maintained to demonstrate compliance with requirements. These include, but are not limited to, manufacturer requirements, safety requirements, sprinkler systems, water testing, fire alarms and fuel systems.

Every home for special care shall have a medical health advisor who shall be a duly qualified medical practitioner.
