Requirements resulting from licensing inspection:

1. LTCPR 7.2.3

The licensee shall ensure resident council meetings are held monthly. Residents and/or authorized designates are notified of meetings in advance and are encouraged to participate.

2. LTCPR 8.4.12

The licensee shall ensure staff influenza immunization rates, in homes with greater than 5 employees, are posted in a public place and updated a minimum of twice per year on December 15th and on March 1st.

3. LTCPR 6.1.3

The licensee shall ensure results of assessments are documented on the resident record, are communicated appropriately to staff and become the basis for the resident plan of care.

4. LTCPR 6.2.16

The licensee shall ensure a stand-alone wound care committee is implemented, or wound care issues/practices are included as a standing agenda item on another appropriate committee (i.e. Quality Committee). The committee shall be interdisciplinary ensuring that wound prevention and management is regularly reviewed and revised to reflect leading practices and provincial direction and identify trends for quality improvement.

5. LTCPR 8.4.3

The licensee shall ensure a stand-alone Infection Prevention and Control Committee is implemented or infection prevention and control issues/practices are included as a standing agenda item on another appropriate committee. The committee shall be multidisciplinary ensuring that the infection prevention and control program is regularly reviewed and revised to reflect leading practices and provincial direction.

6. LTCPR 12.1.6

The licensee shall ensure hazardous products that may be harmful to residents are secured at all times and are not accessible to residents. They are stored and disposed of in accordance with established safety practices/manufacturers' recommendations.

7. LTCPR 8.5.4

The licensee shall ensure medications are accounted for, administered and documented in accordance with federal and provincial legislation and professional practice standards.

8. LTCPR 7.3.3

Requirements for Nursing Homes - The licensee shall ensure family council meetings are held a minimum of twice annually. Family members are notified of meetings in advance and are encouraged to participate.

Outstanding requirements from previous inspection(s):

- Date of inspection: May 24, 2023 and July 19, 2023 LTCPR 12.2.2.c. The licensee shall ensure aesthetic, functional and surface integrity of the following are maintained: interior building components such as, but not limited to, partitions, ceilings, doors, casework, coatings and sealants.

Date of inspection: May 24, 2023 and July 19, 2023 LTCPR 6.1.9 Additional Requirements for Nursing Homes - Additional interdisciplinary assessments (including but not limited to Physiotherapy, Dietitian and Recreation) should be completed within two weeks following admission to the home, and on an ongoing basis in accordance with the residents' individual needs.
