Requirements resulting from licensing inspection:

1. LTCPR 7.3.3
Requirements for Nursing Homes - The licensee shall ensure family council meetings are held a minimum of twice annually. Family members are notified of meetings in advance and are encouraged to participate.
2. HSCR 38(2), LTCPR 8.5.3
The licensee shall ensure medications are stored in a secure and appropriate manner, accessible only to persons authorized to administer medications.
3. LTCPR 6.1.9
Additional Requirements for Nursing Homes - Additional interdisciplinary assessments (including but not limited to Physiotherapy, Dietitian and Recreation) should be completed within two weeks following admission to the home, and on an ongoing basis in accordance with the residents' individual needs.
4. HSCR 19(1)(d), LTCPR 11.1.6
The licensee shall ensure the home provides a documented, timely orientation for all staff members, volunteers and contracted personnel. The orientation provides the necessary information to support residents in a safe manner and improve their quality of life.
5. LTCPR 8.4.10
The licensee shall ensure if bars of soap and other personal care items are used in resident rooms, they are designated for the use of one resident and are not shared.
6. HSCR 44A(2), LTCPR 6.2.15
Additional Requirements for Nursing Homes - The licensee shall ensure an interdisciplinary pharmacy committee, consisting of at least the Administrator of the Home, Medical Advisor, Pharmacist, Director of Resident Care and Clinical Dietitian, meets a minimum of every six months. The pharmacy committee shall meet regularly to establish and monitor guidelines consistent with these regulations in relation to the storage, administration and control of drugs in the home.

The licensee shall ensure the following processes are developed and followed:
labeling of food in refrigerators and discarding of expired food.

The licensee shall ensure resident council meetings are held monthly.
Residents and/or authorized designates are notified of meetings in advance and
are encouraged to participate.
- 9.** LTCPR 8.5.15
The licensee shall ensure discontinued and expired medications are disposed in
a safe and appropriate manner.
- 10.** LTCPR 11.1.11
Additional Requirements for Nursing Homes - The licensee shall ensure the
home is staffed in accordance with the staffing model as funded by the
Department.
- 11.** LTCPR 6.2.9
The licensee shall ensure interventions are in accordance with resident goals of
care, clinical guidelines, leading practices and the professional
regulatory/licensing bodies.
