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Licensing Inspection Report (Annual Inspection)

Requirements resulting from licensing inspection:

1. LTCPR 8.4.10

The licensee shall ensure if bars of soap and other personal care items are used in resident rooms, they are designated for the use of one resident and are not shared.

2. LTCPR8.5.5.b

The licensee shall ensure there is a process in place for tracking narcotics.

3. LTCPR 8.2.1.g

The licensee shall ensure policies and procedures that minimize risk to residents, staff, volunteers, visitors and the home are developed and followed. These include but are not limited to a safety alerts policy and procedures that includes information management, follow up actions and risk mitigation.

4. LTCPR 6.3.10

Additional Requirements for Nursing Homes - The licensee shall ensure each resident's plan of care is based on the risks and needs identified in the interdisciplinary assessments referenced in section 6.1, Additional Requirements for Nursing Homes, and the resident's choice.

5. LTCPR 6.3.2

The licensee shall ensure an interdisciplinary care conference, that includes the resident and/or authorized designate and the family members approved by the resident, is conducted within six weeks of admission to the home and annually thereafter, or more frequently as the resident's individual needs require.

6. HSCR 20B, LTCPR 7.4.3

The licensee shall ensure management and staff meetings are held a minimum of quarterly.

7. LTCPR 12.1.4 c

The licensee shall ensure the following processes are developed and followed: ensuring compliance with Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) regulations. Current Material Safety Data Sheets for all applicable products used/stored in the home are maintained and are easily accessible to staff members.

8. LTCPR 6.1.5b

Additional Requirements for Nursing Homes - The licensee shall ensure residents have a skin integrity assessment completed within 24 hours of admission to the home, and on an ongoing basis in accordance with the residents' individual needs.

9. LTCPR 12.2.2.c

The licensee shall ensure aesthetic, functional and surface integrity of the following are maintained: interior building components such as, but not limited to, partitions, ceilings, doors, casework, coatings and sealants.

10. LTCPR 6.3.4.b

The licensee shall ensure each resident has a plan of care which is reviewed by staff on a quarterly basis, or more frequently as required, and is updated to reflect the resident's changing needs and interventions.

11. LTCPR 12.1.8

The licensee shall ensure cleaning and disinfectant products and other chemicals used in environmental cleaning are not used after their expiration date.

12. LTCPR 12.1.6

The licensee shall ensure hazardous products that may be harmful to residents are secured at all times and are not accessible to residents. They are stored and disposed of in accordance with established safety practices/manufacturers' recommendations.

13. LTCPR 6.5.2.c

The licensee shall ensure the following processes are developed and followed: labeling of food in refrigerators and discarding of expired food.

HSCR 18(3)

In every nursing home and nursing care section of a home for the aged where there are thirty or more residents, there shall be at least one registered nurse on duty at all times.
