Requirements resulting from licensing inspection:

1. LTCPR 12.1.6

The licensee shall ensure hazardous products that may be harmful to residents are secured at all times and are not accessible to residents. They are stored and disposed of in accordance with established safety practices/manufacturers' recommendations.

Outstanding requirements from previous inspection(s):

1. Date of inspection: June 30, 2021, November 10, 2021 LTCPR 8.2.1.q

> The licensee shall ensure policies and procedures that minimize risk to residents, staff, volunteers, visitors, and the home are developed and followed. These include but are not limited to a safety alerts policy and procedures that includes information management, follow up actions and risk mitigation.

2. Date of inspection: June 30, 2021, November 10, 2021 LTCPR 7.3.3

> Requirements for Nursing Homes - The licensee shall ensure family council meetings are held a minimum of twice annually. Family members are notified of meetings in advance and are encouraged to participate.

3. Date of inspection: June 30, 2021, November 10, 2021 LTCPR 6.3.4.b

> The licensee shall ensure each resident has a plan of care which is reviewed by staff on a quarterly basis, or more frequently as required, and is updated to reflect the resident's changing needs and interventions.

4. Date of inspection: June 30, 2021, November 10, 2021 LTCPR 8.5.4

> The licensee shall ensure medications are accounted for, administered, and documented in accordance with federal and provincial legislation and professional practice standards.

5. Date of inspection: June 30, 2021, November 10, 2021 LTCPR 6.1.5a

Additional Requirements for Nursing Homes - The licensee shall ensure residents have an interdisciplinary assessment of risk, functional abilities, cognition, nutrition, oral health (see section 6.6), pain and discomfort, falls risk, and recreation, initiated upon admission to the home and completed within two weeks.
