## Requirements resulting from licensing inspection:

#### **1.** LTCPR 8.4.9.d

The licensee shall ensure the home implements a hand hygiene program which includes the following: evaluating staff adherence with hand hygiene practices though auditing and observation.

#### **2.** LTCPR 8.5.4

The licensee shall ensure medications are accounted for, administered and documented in accordance with federal and provincial legislation and professional practice standards.

## **3.** LTCPR 9.2.2 c

The licensee shall ensure the Business Continuity Plan is reviewed a minimum of annually and revised as necessary to ensure it is current.

#### **4**. LTCPR 6.3.10

Additional Requirements for Nursing Homes - The licensee shall ensure each resident's plan of care is based on the risks and needs identified in the inter-disciplinary assessments referenced in section 6.1, Additional Requirements for Nursing Homes, and the resident's choice.

#### **5**. LTCPR 12.1.8

The licensee shall ensure cleaning and disinfectant products and other chemicals used in environmental cleaning are not used after their expiration date.

### **6.** LTCPR 6.3.4.b

The licensee shall ensure each resident has a plan of care which is reviewed by staff on a quarterly basis, or more frequently as required, and is updated to reflect the resident's changing needs and interventions.

# **7.** HSCR 20B, LTCPR 7.4.3

The licensee shall ensure management and staff meetings are held a minimum of quarterly.

## **8.** LTCPR 7.3.3

Requirements for Nursing Homes - The licensee shall ensure family council meetings are held a minimum of twice annually. Family members are notified of meetings in advance and are encouraged to participate.

### **9.** LTCPR 8.2.3.c

The licensee shall ensure risk management processes that minimize risk to residents and staff are implemented. These include but are not limited to: a process for documenting and appropriately communicating resident allergies.
