
Licensing Inspection Report (Annual Inspection)

Requirements resulting from licensing inspection:

1. LTCPR 8.5.10
The licensee shall ensure all residents have an individual Medication Administration Record (MAR) accompanied by a current resident photograph.
2. LTCPR 8.5.15
The licensee shall ensure discontinued and expired medications are disposed in a safe and appropriate manner.
3. LTCPR 12.2.2.2.c
The licensee shall ensure aesthetic, functional and surface integrity of the following are maintained: interior building components such as, but not limited to, partitions, ceilings, doors, casework, coatings and sealants.
4. LTCPR 6.8.3, LTCPR 6.8.4
The licensee shall ensure upon admission, and as needed, there is evidence of discussion with residents and/or authorized designates about options for end of life care including options for the degree of medical intervention. Residents'/authorized designates' goals of care and choices are documented accordingly on the plan of care and/or personal directive, if completed, and are placed on the resident record and followed.
5. LTCPR 11.1.7
The licensee shall ensure an orientation checklist, indicating which orientation components have been completed by staff, is signed, dated and maintained in each staff member's personnel file.
6. LTCPR 12.1.8
The licensee shall ensure cleaning and disinfectant products and other chemicals used in environmental cleaning are not used after their expiration date.

7. LTCPR 8.5.6
The licensee shall ensure preparation of doses for more than one administration time is not permitted.
8. LTCPR 6.6.1, LTCPR 6.6.2
The licensee shall ensure an oral health assessment is initiated on admission and completed by staff within two weeks. Any risks relating to oral status (such as pain, swelling, bleeding, broken or decayed teeth, debris and food particles) are documented on admission and monitored regularly by staff in order to initiate appropriate referrals to dental professionals, when required and desired by the resident or authorized designate, and to inform daily mouth care planning.
9. LTCPR 6.3.4.a
The licensee shall ensure each resident has a plan of care which includes the plan's rationale, measurable and achievable goals, benefits, expected outcomes, detailed actions that the interdisciplinary team shall undertake to meet the resident's identified needs and time frames for evaluation.
