Requirements resulting from licensing inspection:

1. LTCPR 6.1.9
Additional Requirements for Nursing Homes - Additional interdisciplinary assessments (including but not limited to Physiotherapy, Dietitian and Recreation) should be completed within two weeks following admission to the home, and on an ongoing basis in accordance with the residents' individual needs.
2. HSCR 38(2), LTCPR 8.5.3
The licensee shall ensure medications are stored in a secure and appropriate manner, accessible only to persons authorized to administer medications.
3. LTCPR 6.3.2
The licensee shall ensure an interdisciplinary care conference, that includes the resident and/or authorized designate and the family members approved by the resident, is conducted within six weeks of admission to the home and annually thereafter, or more frequently as the resident's individual needs require.
4. LTCPR 11.1.2
The licensee shall ensure pre-employment Vulnerable Sector Checks are completed for staff members, students and volunteers at the time of hire and are maintained on file.
5. LTCPR 6.5.2.c
The licensee shall ensure the following processes are developed and followed: labeling of food in refrigerators and discarding of expired food.
6. LTCPR 11.1.6
The licensee shall ensure the home provides a documented, timely orientation for all staff members, volunteers and contracted personnel. The orientation provides the necessary information to support residents in a safe manner and improve their quality of life.

- 7.** LTCPR 12.1.4 c
The licensee shall ensure the following processes are developed and followed: ensuring compliance with Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) regulations. Current Material Safety Data Sheets for all applicable products used/stored in the home are maintained and are easily accessible to staff members.
- 8.** LTCPR 6.1.3
The licensee shall ensure results of assessments are documented on the resident record, are communicated appropriately to staff and become the basis for the resident plan of care.
- 9.** HSCR 21
It is a term and condition of every license that the licensee shall comply with the Acts and regulations, and any orders or directions of an appropriate authority, respecting fire, safety, health and sanitary requirements.
