## Requirements resulting from licensing inspection:

**1.** HSCR 40

There shall be a record kept for each resident of a home for special care who is receiving drugs, and the record shall indicate the resident's name, address, age, sex, weight, food and drug sensitivities and allergies; the type and dosage of drug; the manner in which the drug is to be administered; the physician who prescribed the drug; the date of the prescription and the date of discontinuance.

**2.** LTCPR 8.2.3.c

The licensee shall ensure risk management processes that minimize risk to residents and staff are implemented. These include but are not limited to: a process for documenting and appropriately communicating resident allergies.

**3**. LTCPR 8.5.15

The licensee shall ensure discontinued and expired medications are disposed in a safe and appropriate manner.

## **4**. HSCR 27(4), 9.2.3.c

The licensee shall ensure the Staff Call Back Plan is activated a minimum of once per year to determine the ability of staff members to respond in emergency situations.

## **5**. LTCPR 12.1.6

The licensee shall ensure hazardous products that may be harmful to residents are secured at all times and are not accessible to residents. They are stored and disposed of in accordance with established safety practices/manufacturers' recommendations.

6. HSCR 41(3)

In a home for special care where a registered nurse is not required by Section 18 to be on duty, the administrator, or a person designated by the administrator who is qualified to administer medications in the facility, may accept a verbal order for medication from any of the persons listed in subsection (1) in any of the following circumstances: (a) in an emergency; (b) when the medication does not require a prescription.
