Requirements resulting from licensing inspection:

1. LTCPR 8.5.12

The licensee shall ensure MARs are reviewed and double-checked for accuracy by two authorized staff members before being utilized.

Outstanding requirements from previous inspection(s):

1. Date of inspection: March 30, 2022 and October 19, 2022 LTCPR 8.4.3

The licensee shall ensure a stand-alone Infection Prevention and Control Committee is implemented or infection prevention and control issues/practices are included as a standing agenda item on another appropriate committee. The committee shall be multidisciplinary ensuring that the infection prevention and control program is regularly reviewed and revised to reflect leading practices and provincial direction.

2. Date of inspection: March 30, 2022 and October 19, 2022 LTCPR 12.1.6

The licensee shall ensure hazardous products that may be harmful to residents are secured at all times and are not accessible to residents. They are stored and disposed of in accordance with established safety practices/manufacturers' recommendations.

3. Date of inspection: March 30, 2022 and October 19, 2022 LTCPR 6.2.16

The licensee shall ensure a stand-alone wound care committee is implemented, or wound care issues/practices are included as a standing agenda item on another appropriate committee (i.e. Quality Committee). The committee shall be interdisciplinary ensuring that wound prevention and management is regularly reviewed and revised to reflect leading practices and provincial direction and identify trends for quality improvement.

4. Date of inspection: March 30, 2022 and October 19, 2022 LTCPR12.2.1.6

The licensee shall ensure furnishings selected for the home are made of materials that can be easily cleaned and disinfected.

5. Date of inspection: August 5, 2021; August 12, 2021; March 30, 2022 and October 19, 2022

LTCPR 11.1.8

The licensee shall ensure formalized performance management processes that evaluate staff members' performance annually, and more frequently as necessary, are in place.

6. Date of inspection: August 5, 2021; August 12, 2021; March 30, 2022 and October 21, 2022

LTCPR 8.2.1.g

The licensee shall ensure policies and procedures that minimize risk to residents, staff, volunteers, visitors and the home are developed and followed. These include but are not limited to: a water temperature monitoring policy and procedures to ensure temperatures are in accordance with the appropriate Canadian Standards Association (CSA) standards.

7. Date of inspection: August 5, 2021; August 11, 2021; March 30, 2022 and October 19, 2022

The licensee shall ensure the home's policies are reviewed a minimum of every three years, or more frequently as required to ensure they are current, and they are revised as needed.

Requirements for Nursing Homes - The licensee shall ensure family council meetings are held a minimum of twice annually. Family members are notified of meetings in advance and are encouraged to participate.
